## 1959 PLAYERS TRIP TO WARBURTON



This original photograph is well worn but it is an important item in the club's history of the 1950's.

John had played football with Mulgrave, Rosebud, South Melbourne Reserves and Oakleigh (VFA) before taking on the coaching job at Dromana FC in 1959. 
Front row: Alan McDonald, Alan Holmes, John Seymour, Bob Couacaud.
